

# Funds for fun house

A NEW charity set up by the mother of a handicapped child is holding its first fund-raising event on Saturday.

Alison Lane, of Southwood Avenue, Knaphill, started Face The Future to build a fun house in memory of her son Jake, who died in November 2001, aged three.

Jake was born with Treacher Collins Syndrome, a facial

abnormality, enduring three-and-a-half years of operations and Alison wants the fun house to be used by children with physical needs and their families.

A bouncy castle, football challenge, tombola, barbecue, and several stalls are planned for the event from 1pm to 5pm at Hermitage School, Oakwood Road, St Johns.
